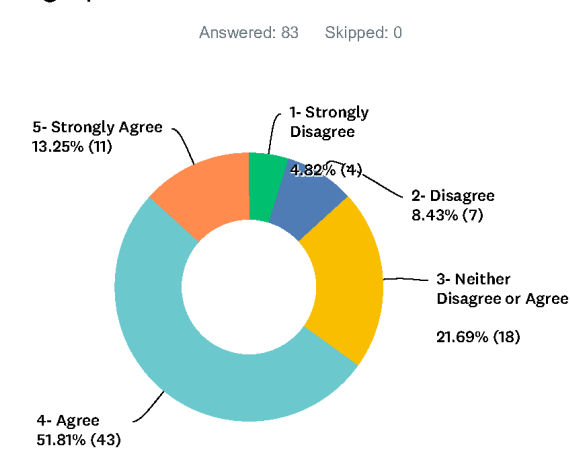


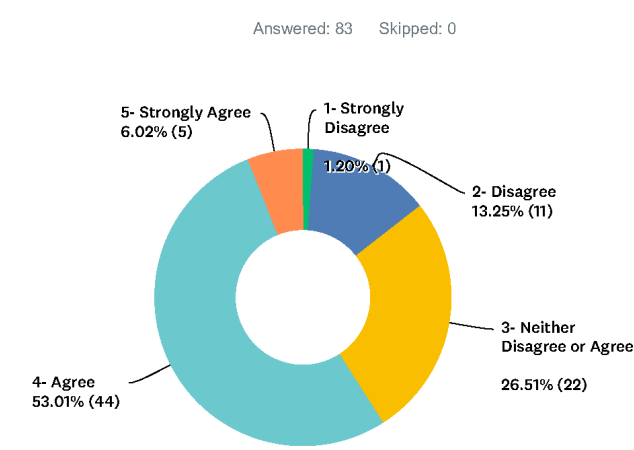


Witness Matters: Telling Your Faith Story

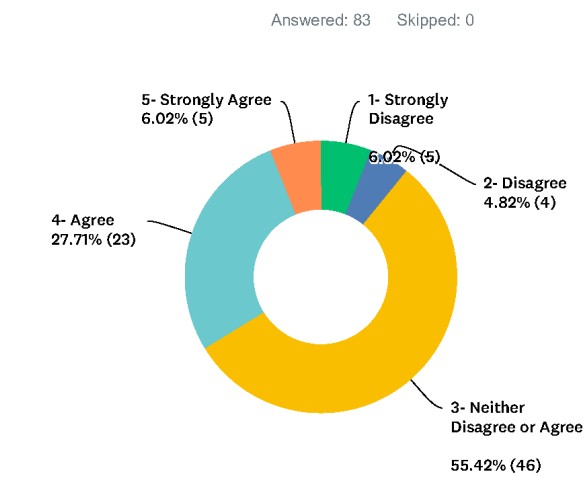
Q1 Homilies encourage parishioners to witness to their faith in word and deed.



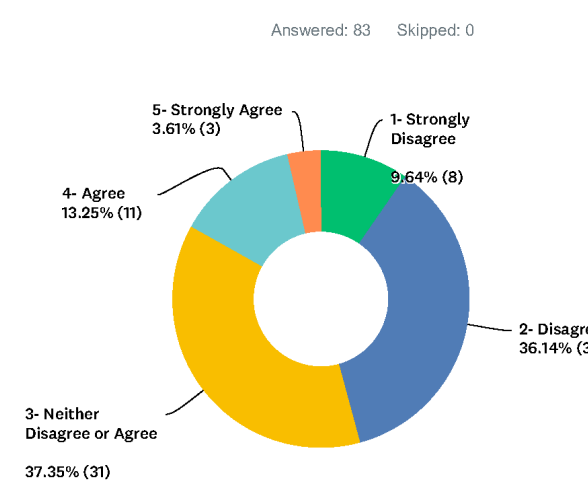
Q2 Homilists incorporate personal witness stories into their preaching.



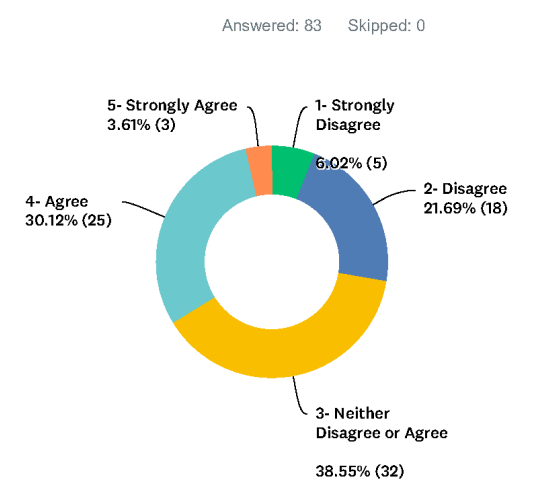
Q3 Laypeople share their personal faith experiences at parish-sponsored events (liturgies, retreats, and missions).



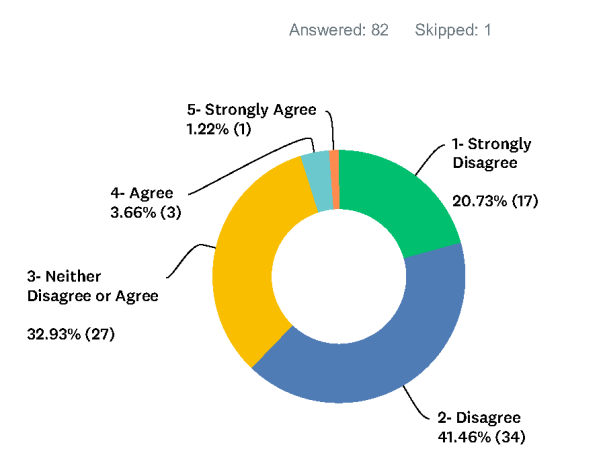
Q4 Parishioners receive guidance on developing their personal faith stories to share with others.



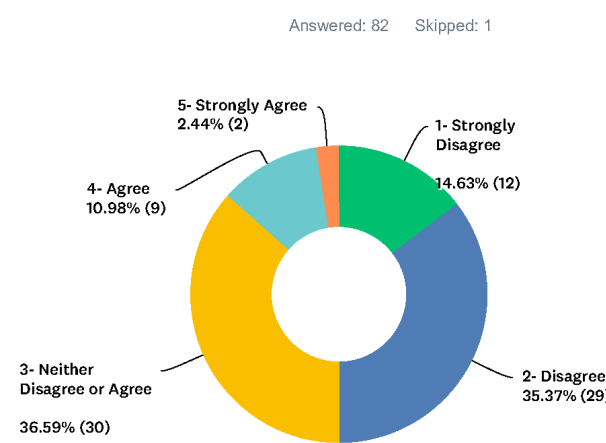
Q5 Parents are equipped in their role as teachers of the Catholic faith to their children.



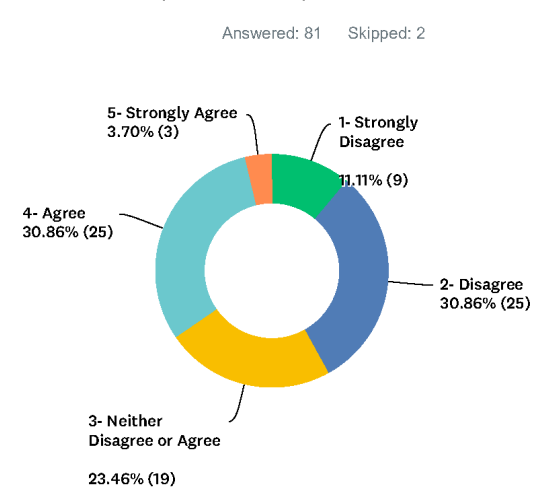
Q6 Parish clergy and staff seek out inactive and alienated members.



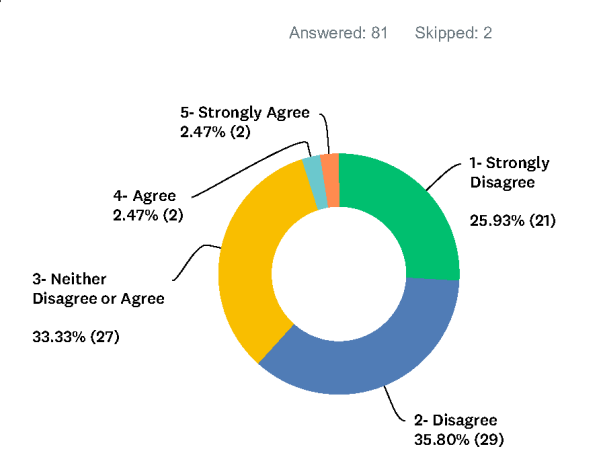
Q7 Our parish trains people to reach out to and invite others to be a part of the parish community.



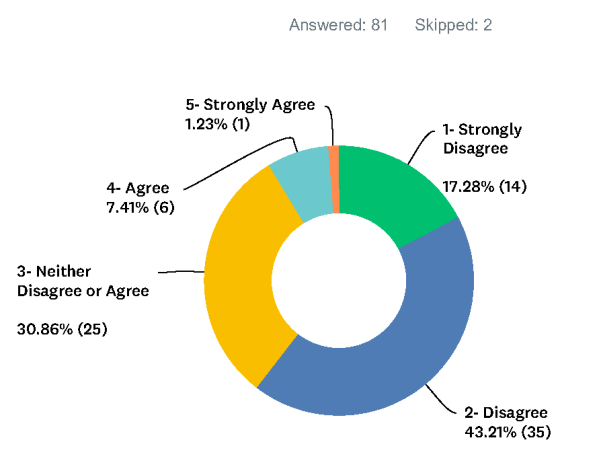
Q8 Our parish regularly sponsors programs specifically designed to evangelize—such as retreats, missions, Christian concerts.



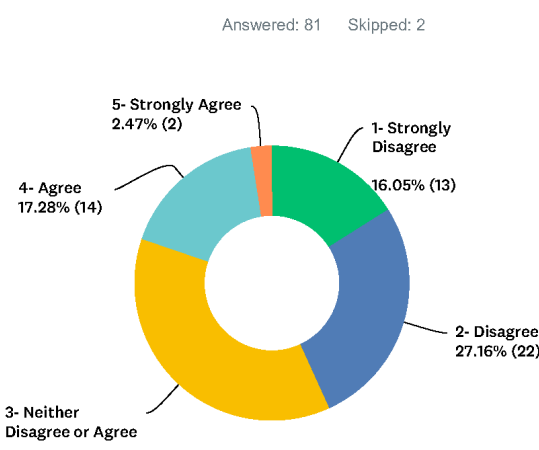
Q9 Our parish is a leader in interdenominational and interfaith activities.



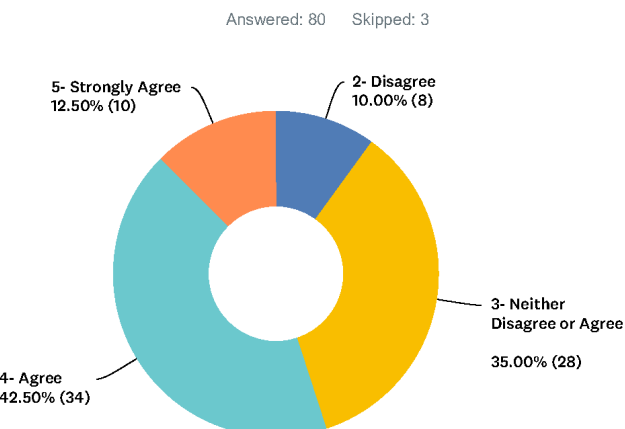

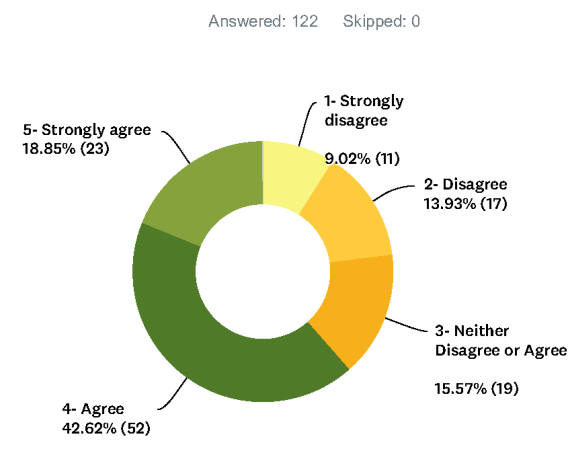


Welcome Matters: Points of Hospitality

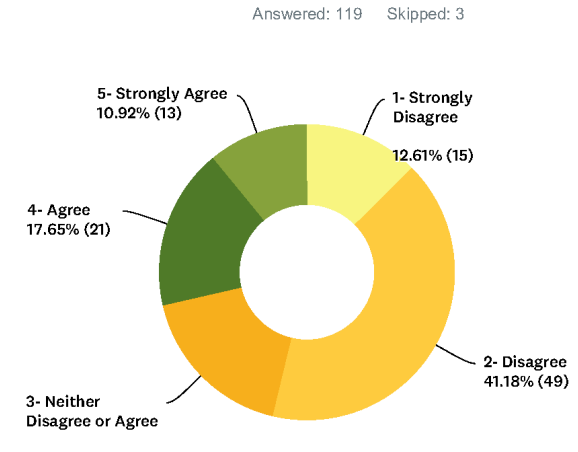
Q1 Signs inside and outside the church are visible and informative.



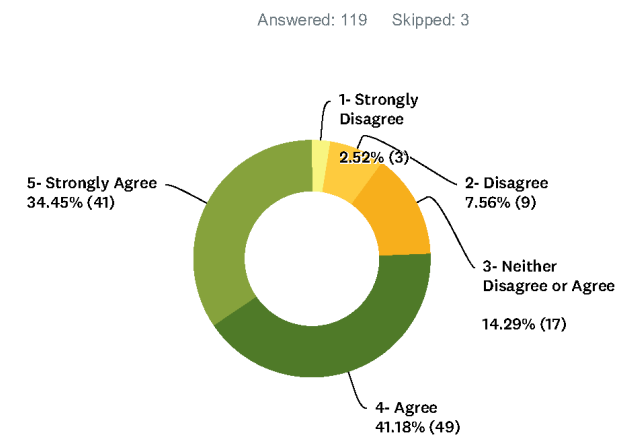
Q2 Our parish facilities are clean and well maintained.



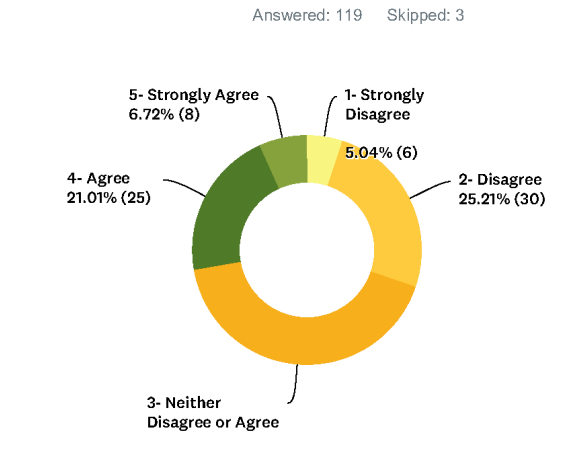
Q3 The facility has accessible parking, entrances, and bathrooms for people with disabilities.



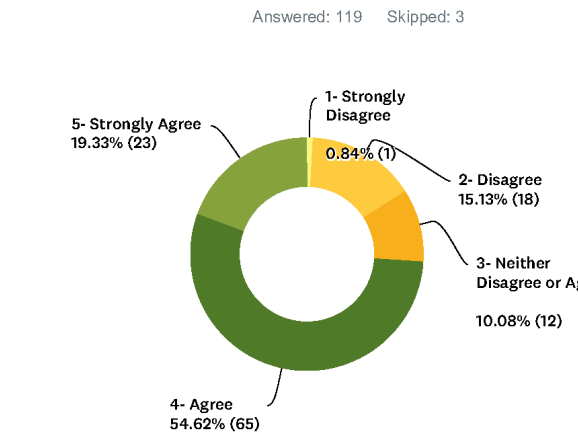
Q4 Greeters/ushers are visible and welcoming.



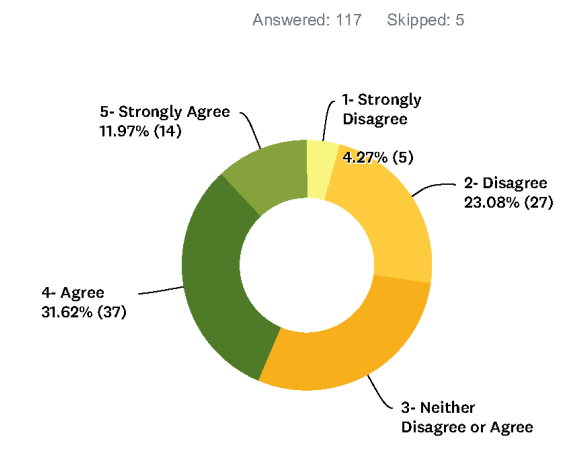
Q5 Parishioners introduce themselves and warmly welcome others into their seats at Mass.



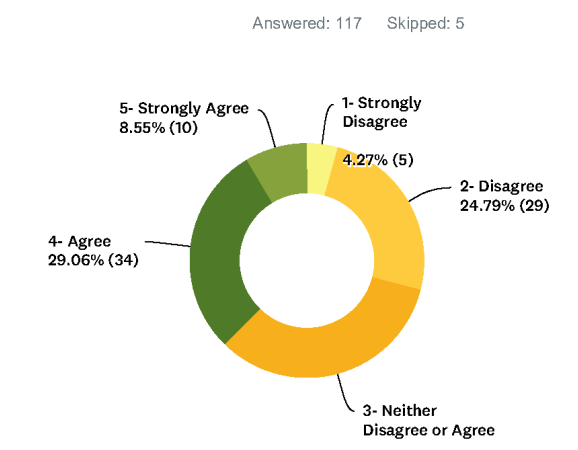
Q6 Our parish provides opportunities throughout the year for people to explore becoming Catholic.



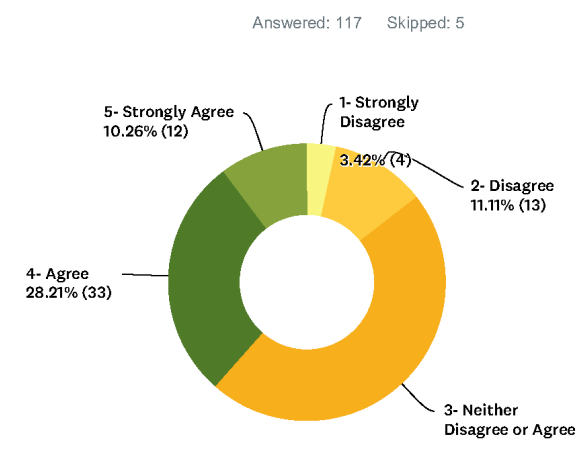
Q7 There are well-publicized and convenient ways to join the parish.



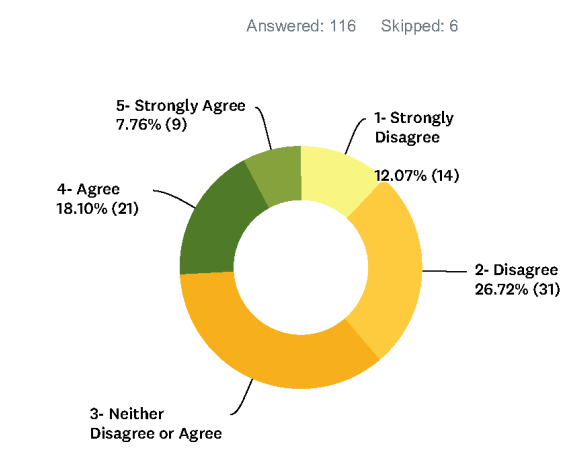
Q8 Our parish staff welcomes parishioners and visitors as honored guests at every point of contact.



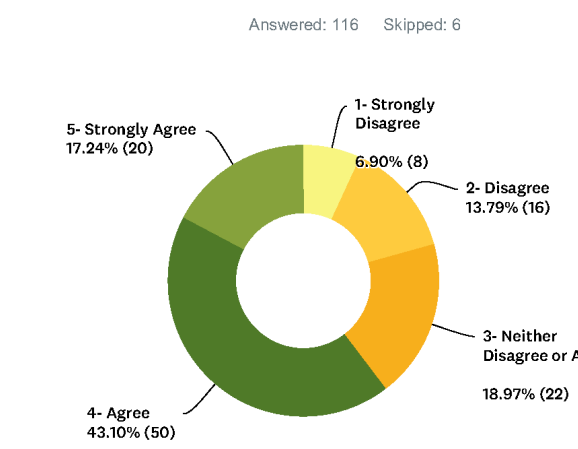
Q9 Members of the parish staff exceed expectations when responding to parishioners' requests.



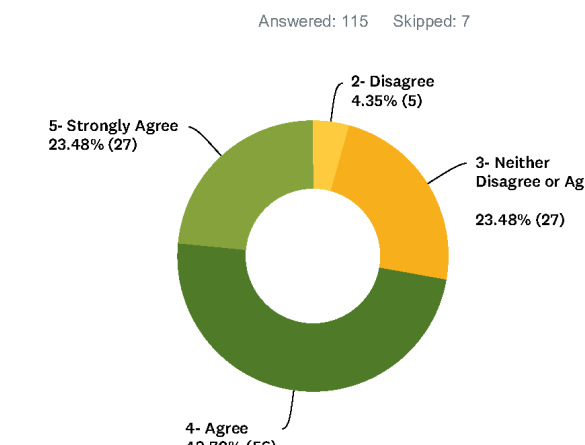
Q10 Our parish reaches out and invites people to join the parish who may feel excluded from parish life (by marital status, race, ethnicity, age, gender, sexual orientation).



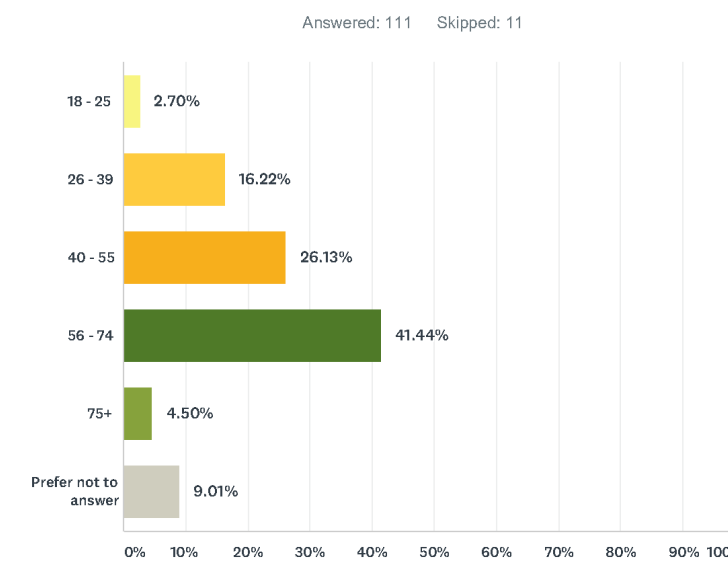

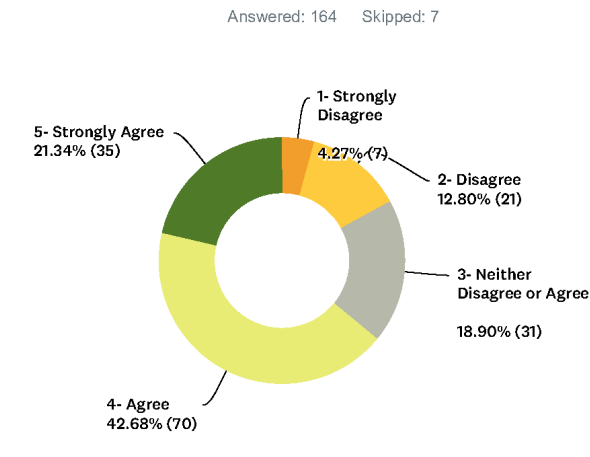


Sunday Matters: The Most Evangelizing Day of the Week

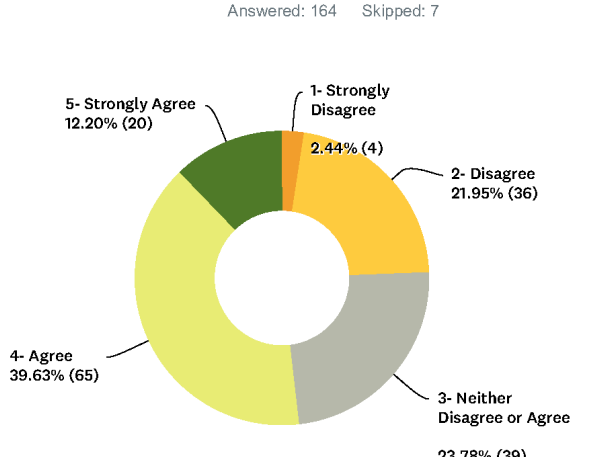
Q1 Greeters/ushers help worshippers find appropriate seating.



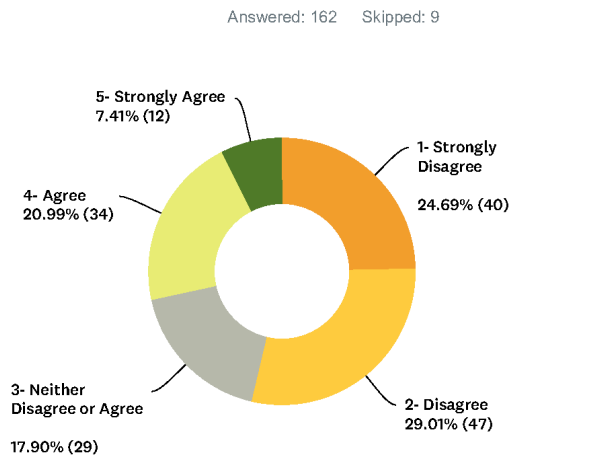
Q2 From the sanctuary, the priest celebrant extends a warm welcome to the gathered community.



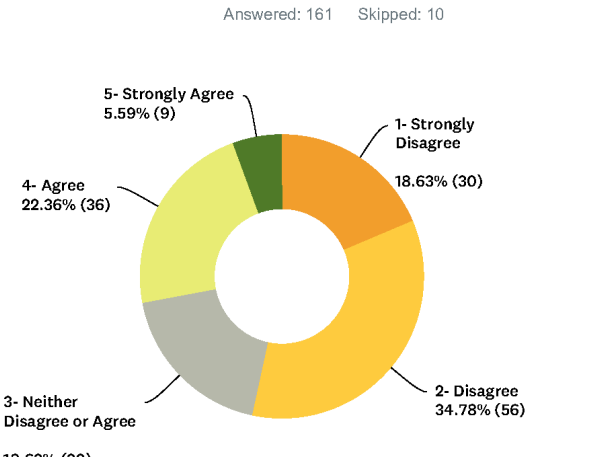
Q3 The physical environment (temperature and lighting) at Mass is comfortable.



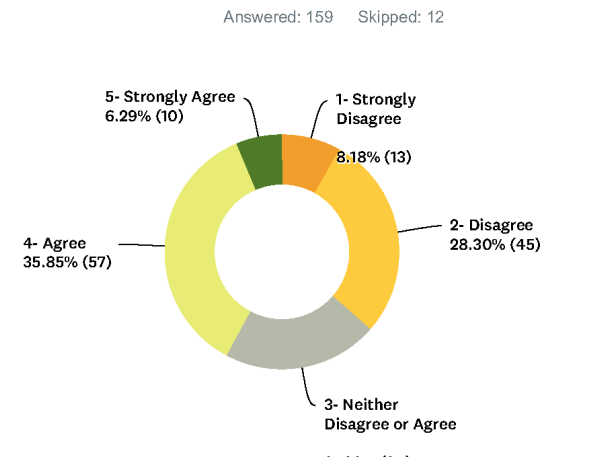
Q4 The choice and quality of the music helps me to engage in the worship.



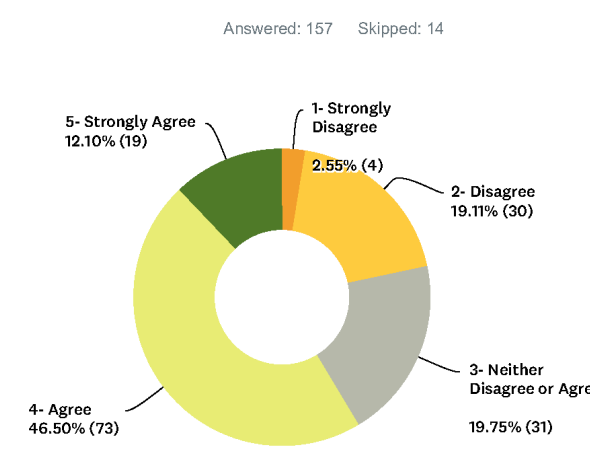
Q5 The music is easy to sing.



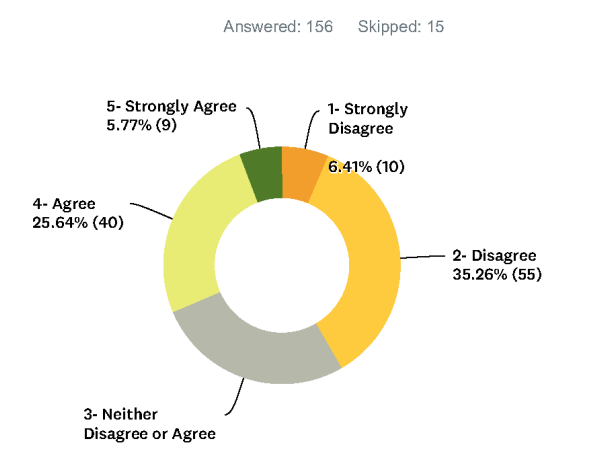
Q6 The audio system provides clear and audible sound throughout the church.



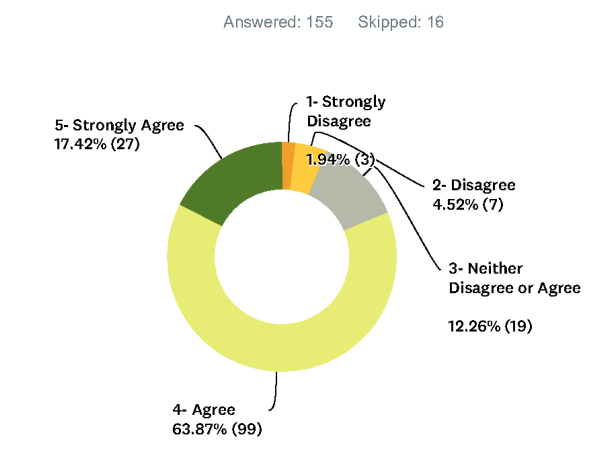
Q7 Homilies are connected to the liturgy, the scripture readings, and the real-life experiences of the community.



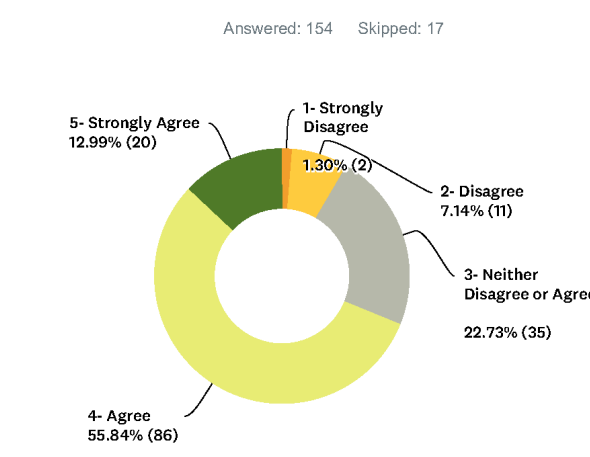
Q8 The congregation fully and actively participates in the prayers and songs, supported by appropriate worship aids.



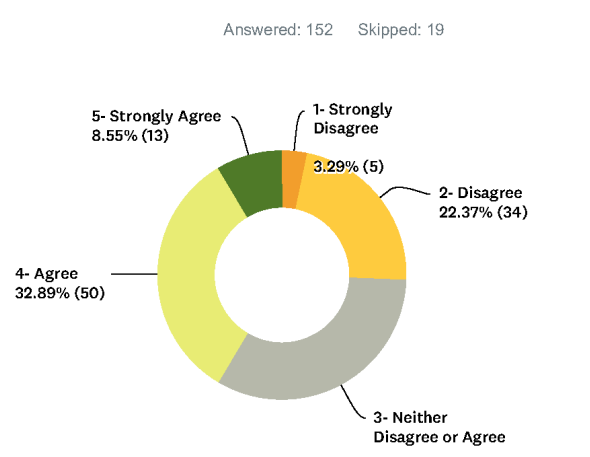
Q9 Lectors proclaim the Scriptures clearly and meaningfully.



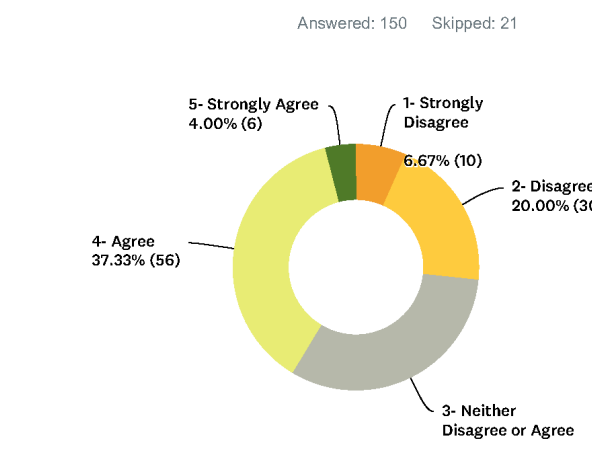
Q10 The liturgical ministers (lectors, extraordinary ministers of holy Communion, altar servers, etc.) represent the age and ethnic diversity of the parish.



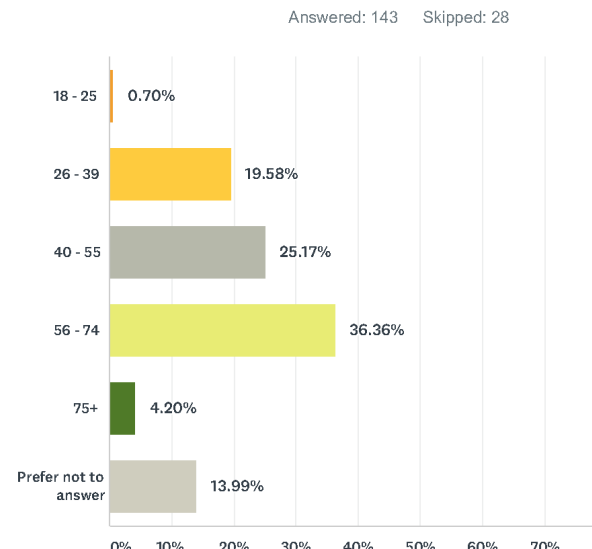
Q11 The celebration of the weekend Masses (particularly the homily and music) reflects the diversity of the parish community (language, culture, demographics).



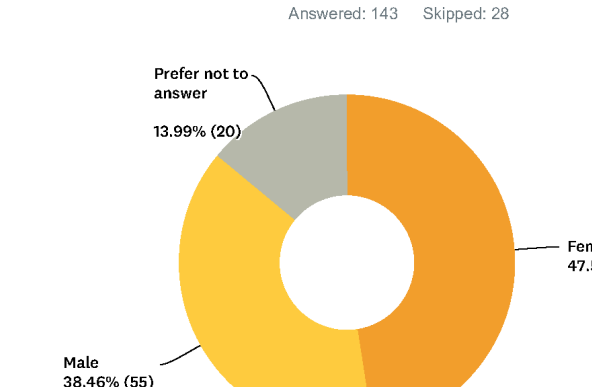

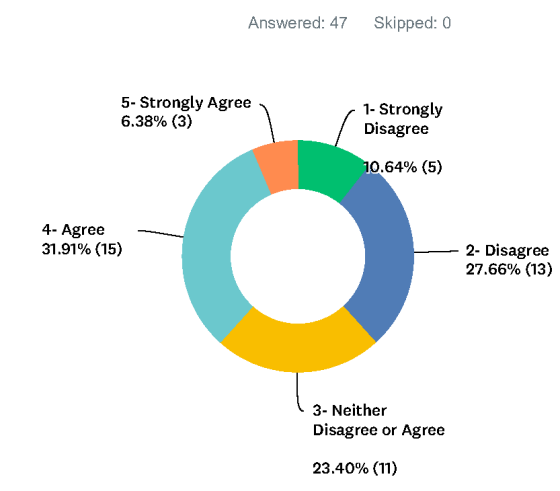


Mission Matters: Reaching Out to the Margins

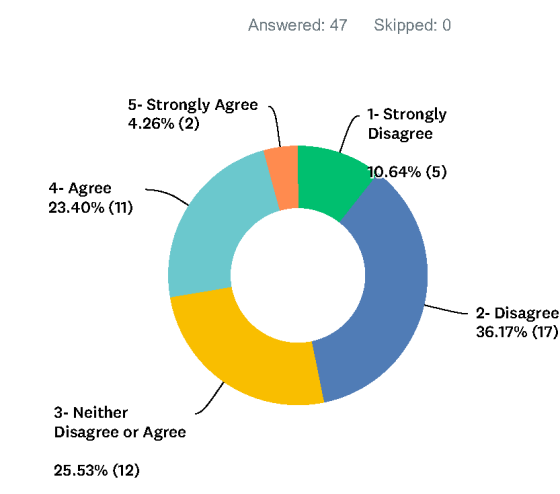
Q1 Our clergy, parish staff, and ministry leaders communicate the importance of the parish being in constant missionary outreach.



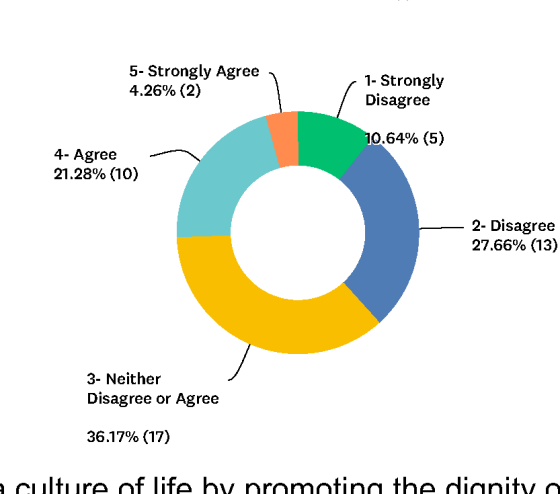
Q2 Our parish provides formation for parishioners of all ages to grow in understanding of Church teaching on charity and social justice.



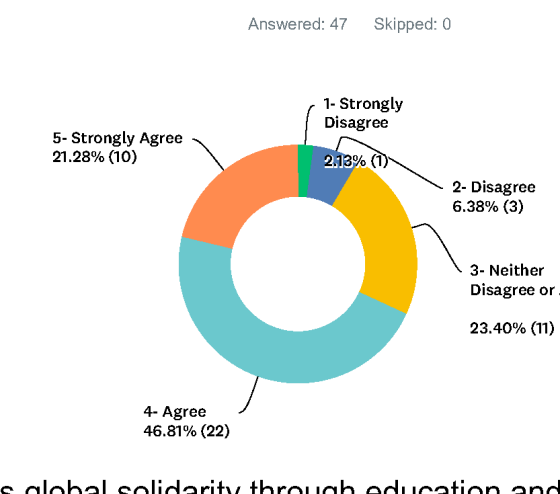
Q3 Our parish has an intentional process for identifying the needs of people who live in the surrounding area.



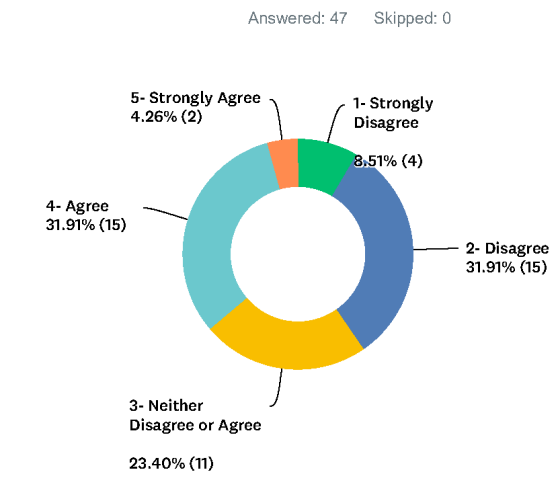
Q4 Our parish has an intentional process for discerning how to respond to identified needs.



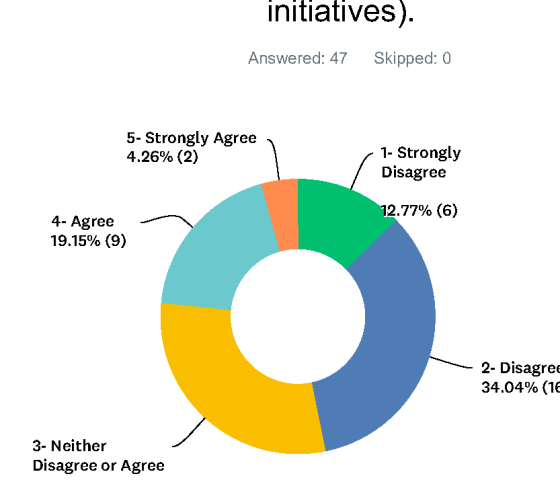
Q5 Our parish builds a culture of life by promoting the dignity of human life from conception to natural death.



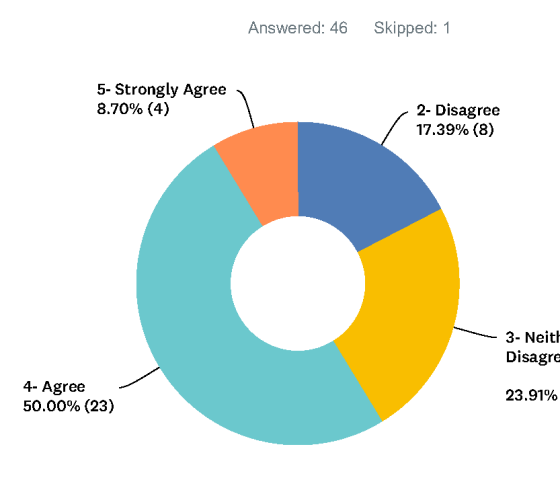
Q6 Our parish fosters global solidarity through education and outreach to our brothers and sisters across the world.



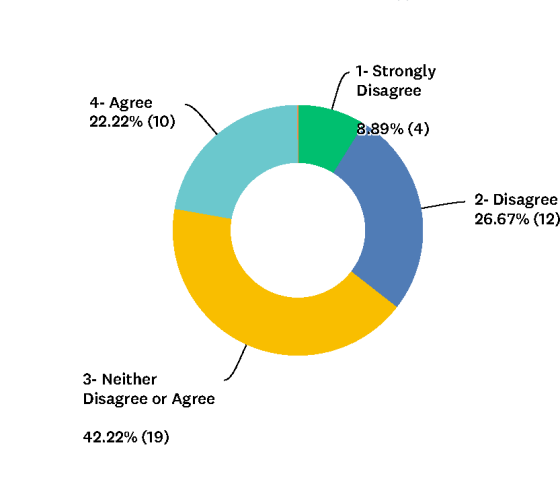

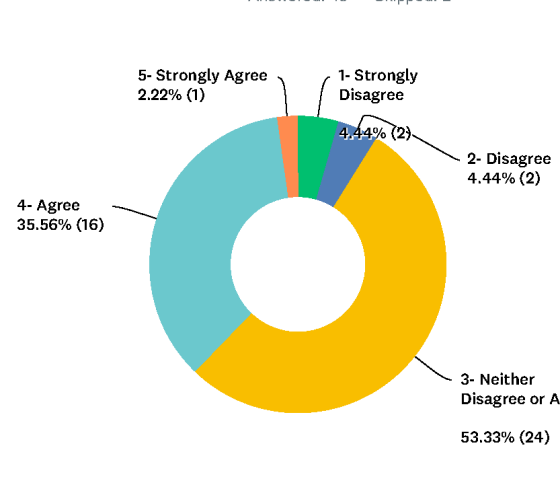
Q8 Parishioners volunteer for projects that address identified needs (e.g., mission trips, food pantries, homeless outreach).



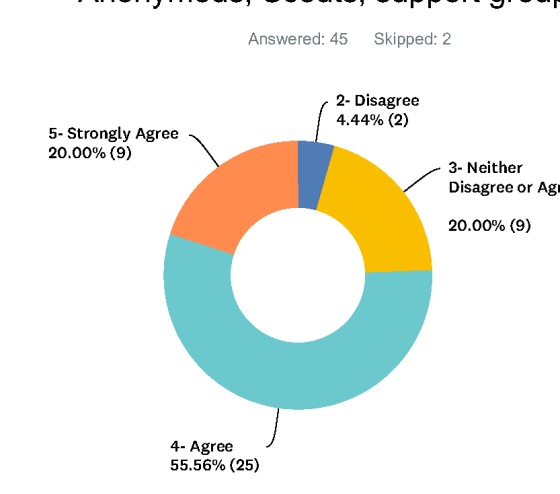

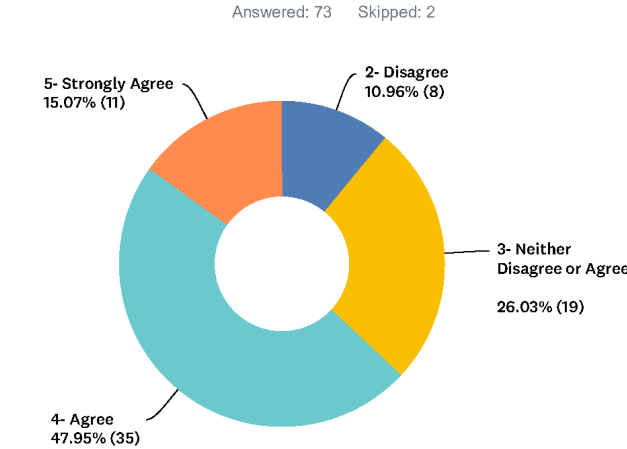


Belonging Matters: Building Parish Engagement

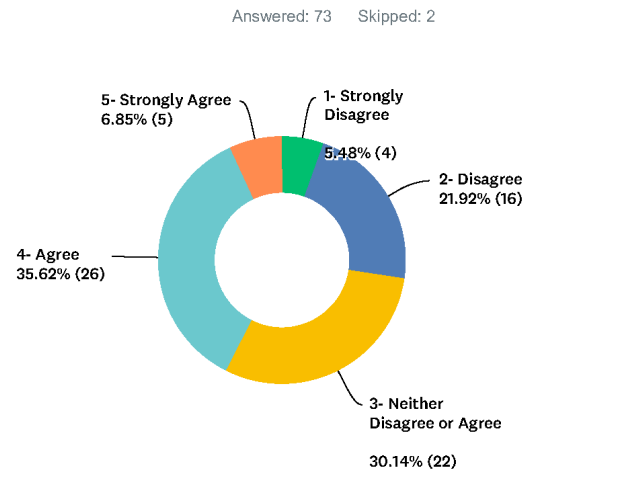

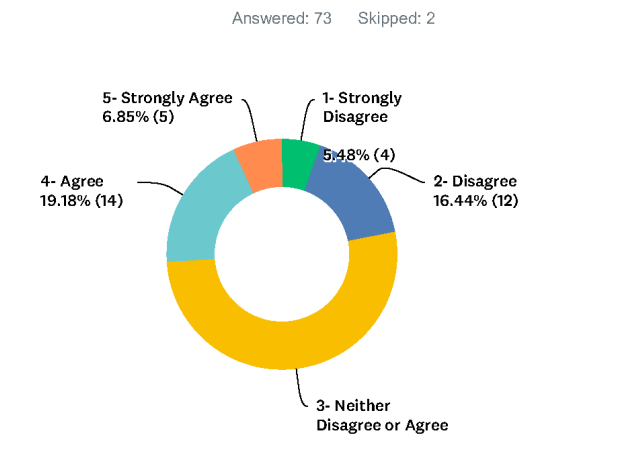

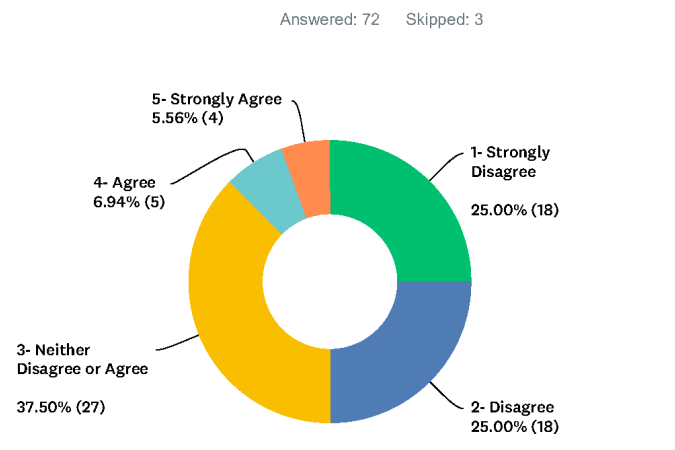
Q3 Our parish activities are designed to engage all the different household types and age groups.



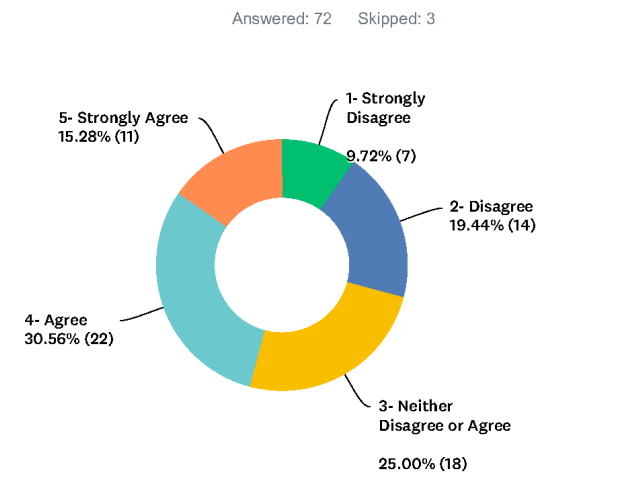
Q4 Our parish follows a plan to involve newly initiated Catholics into the life and ministry of the parish.



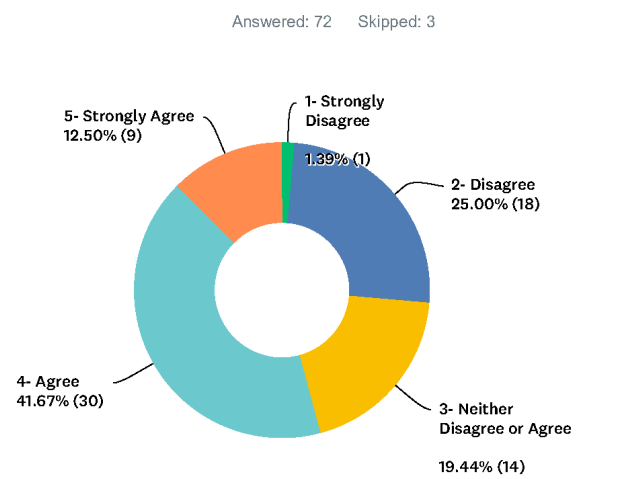
Q5 Our parish has youth ministry programs that attract strong participation beyond sacramental preparation.



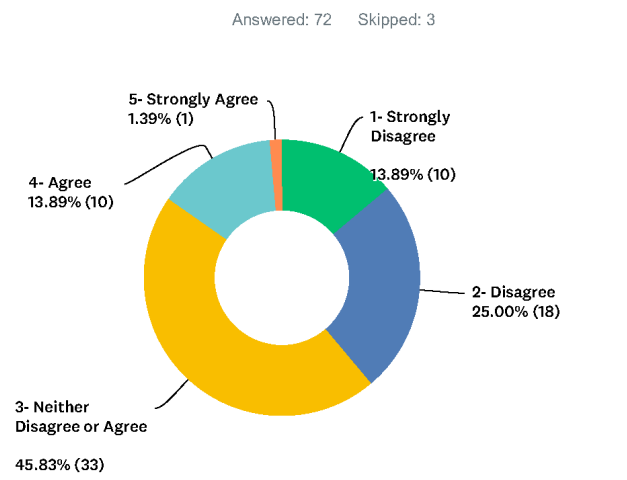
Q6 Parishioners are empowered to use their gifts and talents for the good of the parish.



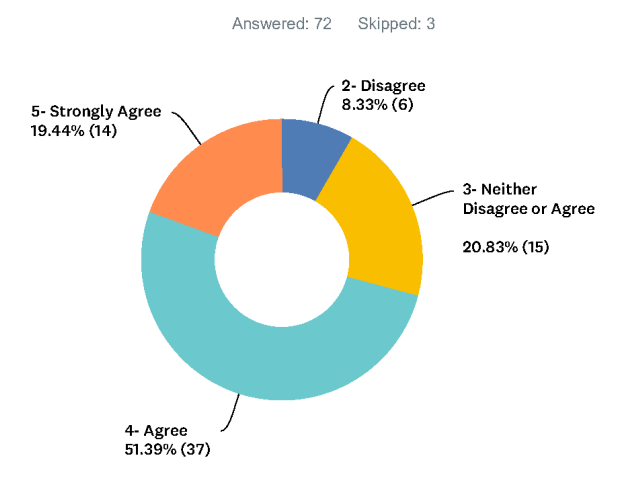
Q7 Our parish organizations regularly invite new people to participate in their activities.



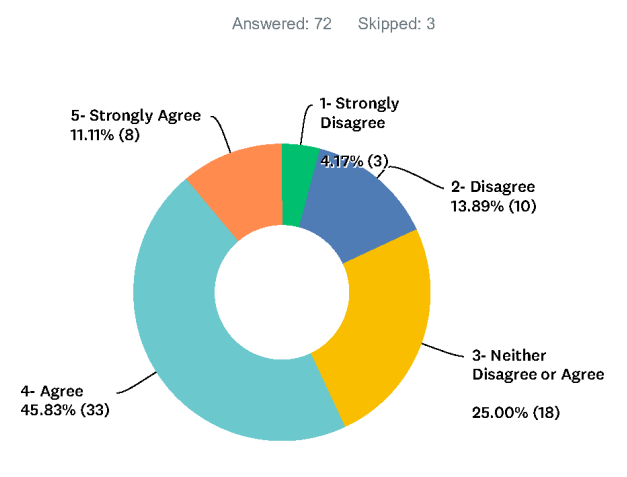
